
About Us

Who are we? We are a 100% foreign-invested, owner-operated business about two hours to the west of Shanghai in China. We have been operating in China since 2007. The company has about 40 local employees.

As a foreign-owned business in China we bring Western professionalism and lower operating costs together to offer consistent high quality at a reasonable price.

Who are our customers? Our main customers are retailers and wholesalers in Japan and Australia. But we also ship directly to individuals and builders for our specialty parquetry.



Solid Wood Flooring **European Oak**

Our Oak is sourced from Burgundy in France and also from the region immediately north of Vienna in Austria. The species are Quercus robur and patraea. All our Oak is seasoned and kiln dried in Europe. We mostly purchase unedged boules and edge them in our factory to get the sizes that we need. In China we only do redrying and reconditioning.

Our range of solid Oak flooring is extensive, from long 220s to regular 125mm random length. We also produce finger joint as well as many sizes of herringbone and chevron parquetry. In addition we do bespoke pattern parquetry for special jobs.

The versatility of Oak is legendary. It is the world's most popular flooring species for good reason. It can be finished in a wide range of colours and treatments.

Oak is functional, beautiful and stable. A solid Oak floor will last for decades and can be refinished in-situ occasionally in keeping with current trends.







Solid Wood Flooring **Australian Cypress**

Our Cypress is a native timber of Australia and we source it from the State of Queensland. Cypress is a highly versatile wood that can be used both indoors and out. It is used as a structural as well as a decorative timber. It is renowned for its termite resistance.

Cypress is a wood for wood lovers who appreciate its unique qualities and its enormous range of colours and patterns. It has a superfine grain due to its slow growth and its shrinkage rate from green to dry is among the lowest of all commercial timbers. There is no other timber like Cypress. It is harder and denser than Oak. It is pleasantly fragrant and it is resistant to moulds, bacteria and insects. It is also highly water resistant because it contains natural oils and will perform well in situations where other woods will distort.

Finishes include fine sanded, oiled or lacquered.



Solid Wood Flooring Australian Jarrah



Jarrah is a Eucalyptus species that is only found in the Southwest of Western Australia.

It is highly esteemed for flooring, high-end furniture as well as decking and out-door furniture. It has also been favoured for railway sleepers and for structural use. The colour of Jarrah varies from light pink to dark red.



Stair Components Treads, Risers and Nosings

We make a range of stair components to match our flooring products. This cannot be done by machine in most cases. Where necessary we hand finish our components to get a perfect match.

Treads may be single layer where the timber thickness allows it, or laminated for heavy treads used in open staircases. Where laminated we use high-quality glue from Japan that is both strong and free from chemical emissions.

We produce various profiles and finishes in stair nosings to suit the floorboards to which they are being matched. We have much experience in producing wire brushed and bandsawn finishes in limewash or other complex effects for architectural jobs.







Parquetry Design Parquetry

We have a lot of experience in making unique design parquetry in solid wood. This requires both careful planning and much skill in its execution. Accurate cutting and high tolerances are very important. Our workers are very proud of their parquetry skills and design parquetry always presents new challenges that push them to extend these skills.

The range of design parquetry is limited to some extent by the properties of wood, but in most cases if you can imagine it, we can make it.



Parquetry Herringbone


Herringbone parquetry is back in fashion and we have a wide range of sizes and styles to choose from, including clean and conservative to rustic and wild.

Sizes vary from about 40mm wide to 220mm wide. Lengths are normally four to six times the width. Most of our products are made from solid wood, but for the wider sizes we recommend multiply engineered material for stability.

Much of our parquetry is made to order, so let us know your size and budget and we will discuss it with you and propose something.


Parquetry Chevron

Chevron parquetry, also sometimes called Hungarian Point, is also becoming increasingly popular. Whether for commercial or domestic use we can produce the style you need. Whether in pre-finished panels or as loose unfinished, we've got you covered.

The most popular size we do is 90 x 600mm. Note that we calculate the price on the finished size, so you are not going to pay for offcuts and then find you do not have the volume you require. This is a very important consideration with Chevron as some companies calculate the price and area measured from point to point. We see things from your point of view.


Decking Australian Cypress Decking

Australian Cypress is termite, rot and insect resistant without chemical treatment. We recommend that you use a good decking oil to prevent weathering and cracking, but even if left uncoated Cypress will last for years and years.

Cypress is also suitable for cladding and outdoor structural applications.

Much of our Cypress decking is sold in Japan where its natural beauty and durability is appreciated.




Hexidek is a unique patented decking product developed by Ecquality

There are also two ways to make it. One method is to click the base together on the surface to be covered and then to attach the small wooden tiles. That is all there is to it, and the designs you can make are limited only by your imagination. The other way is to purchase the tiles ready made by the case, which is quick and easy, but limits your designs to simple (but effective) repeating patterns. Below is an example using simple pre-made tiles where a second design is used as a highlight.

There are many possible repeating patterns possible with Hexidek and many effective combinations of patterns. A single base colour with a few patterned tiles as highlights is often more effective than a solid block of patterned tiles, but it is all up to you. Hexidek is extremely flexible. If you want to make your own pattern, you can lay down the PE base first and then click the individual wooden tiles to the base as below.









Outdoor Furniture Cypress Deck Kit

Our modular deck kit is solid, strong, easy to assemble and comes with stainless steel hardware. The modules can be assembled in various configurations to suit the particular application. Designs can be modified to your requirements.

Technical Information Wood Species




Oak

We mainly produce Oak from Western Europe, primarily France. The species are Quercus robor and patraea, which are commercially grouped together as European Oak. Oak is one of the world's most popular flooring and furniture timbers and is both stable and very flexible in terms of the finishes that can be achieved.



Jarrah

Eucalyptus marginata is Australia's most sought after and prestigious timber and is used for furniture, flooring and decking. It is a heavy hardwood and is very durable and varies in colour from pink to dark red



Australian Cypress


Callitris glauca grows throughout Australia, but in commercial volumes only in the states of New South Wales and Queensland. It is renowned for its durability, stability and low shrinkage. It is a most versatile timber and is used in construction as well as outdoor furniture, decking, flooring and furniture.

Technical Information Drying


Drying is perhaps the most important single determinant of product quality and defective drying is the main cause of problems for wood products in service. If drying is not correct there will be problems and that is why we dry all our Oak in Europe and our Jarrah in Australia. We also do further checks and oven dry tests on wood when it arrives in the factory and re-dry anything that is not within specification. All our products are moisture tested during and after production to ensure that they are shipped at the correct moisture content. We plastic wrap all export product to ensure that moisture content remains as stable as possible.






A wide range of finishes is available, including fine sanded, wire brushed, smoked and oiled. We use Woca oil from Denmark because this product is safe to apply and does not contain nasty chemical residues. Woca is also well supported in Shanghai. We also finish in Treffert UV oils or lacquers and will consider other oils if required by our customers.

We can work from samples and match your colour or if you have a photograph we can copy it and send our samples for confirmation.

Environmental Sustainability

Ecquality takes environmental responsibility seriously. We only purchases timber from legal and sustainable sources. We only buy from reputable suppliers, most of whom have FSC or PEFC certification, and do not trade in threatened species. Also, as we only purchase our products from Western Europe and Australia, which have highly developed regulatory regimes, the risks of encountering illegal or unsustainable resource is very low. We can provide paperwork to satisfy Lacey Act or other regulatory requirements.

Employee Conditions

We understand that our employees are our greatest asset. We provide a safe and healthy work environment and meet or exceed all our legal obligations. We believe that without a good working environment people cannot be expected to produce good work. Many or our workers have remained with us since our operations began in 2007. Employee retention is a major problem in China, but we do not suffer much from this issue.

All our employees receive superannuation, health insurance and other benefits similar to their counterparts in advanced countries. As a foreign company operating in China we are also much more heavily scrutinised than our local counterparts. Any foreign company with triple bottom line obligations can purchase our products with confidence.
